

IMPORTANT FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

2018-2019 ACADEMIC YEAR

Governor Charlie Baker has proposed including an additional \$7 million in state scholarship funds to cover tuition and fee costs for community college students who qualify for Federal Pell Grants. To be eligible for these additional funds, students must complete a 2018-2019 FAFSA by the Massachusetts deadline of May 1, 2018. Please strongly encourage your students to meet this deadline to take advantage of these additional funds.

SUMMER AT MASSASOIT

Students who are interested in matriculating for the Summer Semester at Massasoit and have graduated prior to the start of the summer semester may be eligible to receive grants and/or loans to cover the cost of summer courses. Please encourage students who are interested in this option to submit an application for Summer and complete the 2017-2018 FAFSA as soon as possible.



NEW ENGINEERING LAB OPENS

This fall, we were excited to open a brand-new engineering lab to support our engineering transfer programs, which are specifically focused on preparing students for transfer to four-year institutions for completion of their bachelor's degree. The program offers four options: civil, chemical, electrical, and mechanical.

The lab features state-of-the-art equipment, including tensile and impact testers, polisher and grinder units, and metrological microscopes.

The lab was built in part through funding from the National Science Foundation and from a Capital Skills Workforce Training Grant from the Baker-Polito administration.

DUAL ENROLLMENT UPDATE



Fifty-nine qualified Dual Enrollment high school students from area schools received a free Spring semester class through the Commonwealth Dual Enrollment Program (CDEP) grant.

In addition there are 63 students taking reduced tuition courses in the Massachusetts Dual Enrollment Program (MDEP) for the Spring semester.

Students from Abington, Blue Hills, Braintree, Brockton, East Bridgewater, Foxboro, Norwell, Old Colony Regional, Oliver Ames, Sharon, Stoughton, Pembroke, and home schools enrolled in a variety of courses, including English, mathematics, sciences, and social sciences.
