 - a. Documentation should be in the form of a statement or report on letterhead or agency stationery from a healthcare, social service provider, or alternate agency. Birth or Death Certificates may also be submitted.
 - b. The documentation should be signed and dated and must address the time period for which you are appealing.
- 3.) A Degree Works plan developed by your academic advisor.
