

Checklist for applying to the Dental Assistant Program for Fall 2019

Please use the following check sheet to help organize your application materials.

All items must be submitted together to the Canton Admissions Office by the priority deadline date of April 12, 2019.

- _____ Attend the **mandatory** Information Session. Applicants must attend an Information Session prior to each application cycle.
- _____ Submit the Massasoit Application for Admission or the 2019-2020 Application for Selective Admissions Program.
- _____ Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
- _____ Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
- _____ Complete Accuplacer Placement Testing.
- _____ Meet the reading, writing, and math prerequisites*.
- _____ Submit information session attendance confirmation.

All applicants will be scored using the enclosed rubric.

*Applicants must have completed developmental English courses (ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) and Fundamentals of Math (Math 010) or received an equivalent Accuplacer Score.
