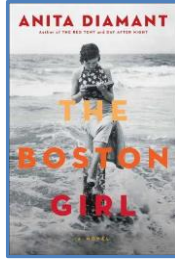

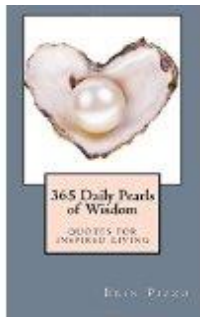

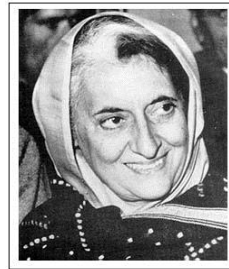
**“Hail To The Chief”: The
