

Massasoit Community College and Curry College to offer 2+2 Associate to Bachelor Criminal Justice Program

Curry College President Kenneth Quigley and Massasoit Community College President Charles Wall signed an agreement on October 18 to offer a 2+2 Transfer Agreement between Massasoit Community College's Associate Degree in Criminal Justice and Curry College's Bachelor of Arts Degree with a major in Criminal Justice.

This new opportunity combines the benefits of a Massasoit associate's degree with the advantages of a Curry bachelor's degree. Students graduating from the Massasoit 2+2 Criminal Justice Program are guaranteed acceptance into the Curry College Criminal Justice Bachelor of Arts Program. Curry College will also offer a renewable Merit Transfer Scholarship in the amount of \$6,500 for Criminal Justice students who have graduated from Massasoit with a minimum 3.0 GPA.
