

Massasoit Community College Announces New Transportation Service Between MBTA Station And Its Middleborough Center

Brockton, MA – Beginning January 21, 2014, students looking for alternative transportation to Massasoit Community College's Middleborough Center will be able to utilize a newly developed GATRA shuttle service. Morning pickup by bus at the Middleborough Commuter Rail Station is scheduled for 7:50 a.m., Monday through Friday, with arrival at the Massasoit Middleborough Center at 8:00 a.m. The afternoon bus will depart the Middleborough Town Hall at 12:44 p.m. and arrive at the MBTA station at 12:50 p.m. in time for students to board the inbound train leaving at 1:08 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Additional GATRA schedule times will be added as ridership increases. Shuttle fare is \$1.00 each way and MBTA zone 5 fare is \$4.00 each way.
