

Massasoit Community College Is Now Offering Free Shuttle Services To/From MBTA Commuter Rail Stations in Randolph and Canton and The Massasoit Canton Campus

Brockton, MA (February 26, 2014) – Beginning March 3, 2014, members of Massasoit's Canton campus community looking for alternative transportation to the college campus will be able to utilize a newly established shuttle service.

The bus departs from the Holbrook/Randolph commuter rail station to the Canton campus with stops at Randolph High School and The Lodge. The first pick up at the rail station is 7:15am and the second at 8:40am. The two return trips leaving the Canton campus for Randolph and Canton are 2pm and 4pm. The service will also be available from the Canton rail stations to the Canton campus. The first morning pick up at Canton Junction is 7:30am and Canton Center at 7:40am. The second pick up is 8:30am at Canton Junction and 8:40am at Canton Center.
