

Massasoit Community College Ink Monkeys Participate in In Owls Live! Festival at The Museum of American Bird Art at Mass Audubon

Canton, MA— On Saturday, March 15th Massasoit Community College's "Ink Monkeys" participated in the Museum of American Bird Art's popular Owls Live! Festival. Over 500 visitors learned about owls with live presentations, games, and art activities for the whole family. Activities included sculpting miniature owl finger puppets out of clay, owl cookie decorating, face painting, and story-telling. Massasoit Community College's costumed "Ink Monkeys" printed more than 200 custom lunch sacks on their printing press and each child participating had opportunity to ink and take home their own owl print. Professor Linda Dunn and the "Ink Monkeys", the Canton Campus based group out of the visual arts program also donated a print to the organization for their raffle.
