Facts about Title IX

- I IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT SPORTS**
Title IX is the landmark 1972 federal civil rights law that prohibits sex discrimination in education.
- II IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT FEMALES**
All students are protected under Title IX regardless of gender identity or expression.
- III FORMS OF SEX DISCRIMINATION PROHIBITED BY TITLE IX**
Sexual harassment and acts of sexual violence such as rape, sexual assault, sexual exploitation, dating violence, domestic violence, and stalking are forms of sex discrimination prohibited by Title IX.
- IV SEXUAL VIOLENCE IS NOT TOLERATED**
Massasoit is proactive in promoting campuses safe and free of sex discrimination and sexual violence.
- V MASSASOIT COMMUNITY COLLEGE CARES**
Massasoit promotes an educational and workplace environment free from all forms of sexual harassment, gender-based harassment, sexual violence, and retaliation. The College will not tolerate such behaviors. We will keep our campuses and surrounding communities safe by responding effectively and immediately if an incident occurs.
- VI MASSASOIT HAS A POLICY**
The policy and procedures for handling incidents of sexual violence are outlined in the Policy on Affirmative Action, Equal Opportunity & Diversity. The Policy can be found posted throughout campus as well as in the Student Handbook and on massasoit.edu.
- VII A PLAN TO KEEP YOU SAFE**
Students involved in incidents of sexual violence have a right to seek and receive referrals to counseling both on- and off-campus and a change in academic schedule.
- VIII RETALIATION IS PROHIBITED**
Any intentional or attempted act against a person who in good faith makes a report, serves as a witness, or participates in an investigation or hearing is a violation of the Policy on Affirmative Action, Equal Opportunity & Diversity.
